GLOSS	Notes by Heinrich von Ligerz. Pp. 1–53 heavily glossed, with Old High German; fragment of commentary of ‘Anonymous of St Gall’.
DECORATION	Initials in red with an occasional touch of purple and green, e.g., pp. 23, 55, 118.
PROVENANCE	A was probably produced in St Gall (Hoffmann); B was produced in Einsiedeln, not Bavaria (Hoffmann). The whole in Einsiedeln by c. 1350.
